Approved buyers receive complimentary hotel stays with breakfast at select Congress hotels on <u>March 26 or 27, 2026</u>; additional nights are self-funded;</li> <li>4. ## Buyer Application and Procedure

- 1. Registration Application:** Complete the "Buyer Application Form" and submit it for approval. Wait for the approval notification;
- 2. Approval:** Once approved, the 2026MIECF Event Manager will issue an approval notice.
- 3. Visa Application:** Before traveling to Macau, arrange valid entry documents, such as the "Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macau" or passport, and "Macau Visa.";
- 4. Matchmaking Appointment:** Complete the "Business Matchmaking Application Form" before the exhibition or arrange appointments with at least 6 exhibitors for onsite meetings;
- 5. Download the App:** Download the exhibition's business matchmaking tool: "ExpoLink" APP, to facilitate on-site matchmaking (for assigned tasks);
- 6. Registration and Check-in:** Upon arrival at the venue, check in at the "Buyer Service Area" to receive entry credentials;
- 7. Task Completion:** Follow the buyer's assigned tasks during the exhibition;
- 8. Task Verification:** After completing tasks, return to the "Buyer Service Area" for task verification and registration fee refund process.

MIECF was launched in 2008 and accredited by the Global Association of the Exhibition Industry (UFI) in 2011. Over the years, it has hosted numerous high-profile events, including themed conferences, exhibitions, forums, project promotions, new product launches, and business matching sessions. In alignment with Macao's strategy of appropriate economic diversification, the MIECF focuses on the green development of the tourism and leisure industry, as well as the four key industries, to further strengthen international cross-sectoral environmental exchange and co-operation between governments, industries, education institutions, research institutes, users and investors. The ultimate goal is to accelerate Macao's appropriate economic diversification while promoting sustainable, high-quality development.

## V. Achievements from the Previous Edition

The 2025 Macao International Environmental Co-operation Forum & Exhibition (2025 MIECF), themed “Innovative Green Development for Building Beautiful Cities,” spanned a total exhibition area exceeding 12,000 square meters, with five dedicated exhibition zones. It highlighted environmental products and services in key areas including carbon neutrality technologies, energy management, water resource management, green mobility, eco-city integration, and green building. The event drew nearly 400 enterprises from close to 40 countries and regions, encompassing more than 40 listed companies from Mainland China and Hong Kong, as well as over 100 companies from Portuguese-speaking countries, Southeast Asia, and Europe. International participation rose by 17% compared to the prior year. Throughout the event, nearly 450 business matchmaking sessions were conducted, over 50 cooperation agreements were signed, and eight companies were successfully attracted to establish operations in Macao. This reinforced Macao’s role as an international platform for green technology exchange and investment, fostering collaboration in environmental fields across government, industry, academia, research, application, and finance sectors.
